Sub: Recognition Certificate for the School under Sub-rule (4) of Rule 11 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the Purpose of Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009

Sir,

With reference to your application dated 03.08.2020 and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant of **Provisional Recognition to Lala Central School, Dhanipur, Lala, Hailakandi for Class Pre-Primary to Class VIII.**

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:

1. The grant of recognition is not in any way implying any obligation to recognize/affiliate the school beyond Class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, (Annexure – 1) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
3. The school shall admit, in Class I, to the extent of 25% of the class, children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till completion. Provided further that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in Paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements, school shall provide separate bank account.
5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission to any child:
  - (a) For lack of age proof.
  - (b) If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed extended period.
  - (c) On the grounds of religion, caste, race, place of birth, or any other discriminatory factor.
7. The School shall ensure
  - (i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary Education in a school.
  - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment,
  - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education,
  - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 19,
  - (v) Inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs as per provision of the Act.
  - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years from the commencement of the Act.
  - (vii) The teacher performs its duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act,
  - (viii) The teacher shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities
  - (ix) Fire security arrangements as per norms specified under the National Building Code of India Part 4 are set up.
  - (x) Fee to be charged from the children is notified every year in such manner as directed by the Commissioner, Rajya Shiksha Kendra before the commencement of academic session & District Education Officer is intimated before the beginning of academic session.

8. The school shall follow the curriculum laid down by appropriate authority
9. The school shall enroll student proportionate to the facilities available in the school as pre in section 19 of the Act.
10. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
11. The School buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
12. The school is run by a Trust registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1850), or The Charitable and Religious Trust Act (Act XIV of 1920) & Indian Trust Act 1882.
13. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statement should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the Statement of accounts should be sent to the DEEO every year.
14. The recognition Code Number allotted to your school is DEEO/HKD/2025/02  
This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.
15. The school furnished such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/Dist. Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Govt. /Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies if working of the school.
16. Renewal of Registration of Society/Trust if any, be ensured.
17. The School shall always be run as a private institution and will not claim for any grants-in-aid or seek Provincialisation by the government in future.
